LIGHT

The Light model, is the smallest of our four models, the round shape of the Light offers the most familiar feeling to a standard tube-sized hand rim. **Colors:** available in 6 popup colors and 3 standard colors, **Cross-section:** 20mm **Grip:** good grip, **Recommended hand size:** small,





MEDIUM

The Medium model is the smallest of the oval shapes. It offers a larger surface to grip than the Light model. **Colors:** available in 6 popup colors and 3 standard colors, **Cross-section:** 20x24mm, **Grip:** good grip, **Recommended hand size:** average and small,

BIG

The Big model is our largest of the oval shapes. The larger profile shape provides a larger surface for gripping than the Light and Medium models. This reduces the effort and increases the power and efficiency when driving. Also an improved control when braking is made possible by these form.

Colors: available in 6 popup colors and 3 standard colors, **Cross-section:** 20x30 mm,

Grip: good grip,

Recommended hand size: average and big,





PRIME

The Prime model has a unique ergo shape, with an added thumb track. This model offers the most effective grip contact available. **Colors:** available in 6 popup colors and 3 standard colors, **Grip:** good grip, **Cross-section:** 25x30 mm, **Recommended hand size:** average and big,

WoodRubb

The WoodRubb model has the shape of the Prime model but is optimally complemented by a robust and replaceable silicone lip. This combination offers excellent grip and is also suitable for people with lower hand strength. The black silicone lip is a real eye-catcher with any chosen pop-up color or the natural color.

Colors: available in 6 popup colors and 3 standard colors, Grip: excellent grip, Cross-section: 25x30 mm, Recommended hand size: average and big,

Natur

The natuiral finish offers an organinc appeal, only found with Lignorim. The natural color will wear well over time.



Dark

The dark color brings out the wood grain of the ash and creates a natural looking rim with a unique dark coloring.



Intense Black

Black leads the line up in our range of colors. Classic, thinning and timeless, black will look good in all situations.



If you wish every sunset was the color of tangerines, this is the rim for you. A bright pop for your wheels.



Veggie

The name says it all! Green like fresh cut grass will bring a splash of springtime to each day.



Lagoon

The lagoon blue is matches well with that seaside mentality. Easy on the eyes like a calming sea.







Poppy

The Poppy flower blooms a beautiful red petal. You want a red that really 'pops'? Meet the Poppy color.


Piglet

The color is as fun as the name! This rim allows for some of the ash wood grain to come through, making for a pink that pairs well with everything.

Dragonfurit

Somewhere between Poppy and Piglet lives Dragonfruit - an almost-purple hue that is rich and bright.

Technology



Ash wood

Due to the use of ash wood, there are no wood splinters and consequently there is no risk of injury from them.

Laminar construction

This results in a homogeneous rim cross-section that remains dimensionally stable even in direct contact with water.

Surface

The surface of the handrims is treated with a strongly water and heat resistant colour oil. The colour oil is absolutely solvent-free and thus protects the environment as well as your health!

General

Our handrims feel more comfortable to the user than those made of metal. Especially in the cold season the touch of metal parts and the associated cooling of the hands is quite uncomfortable. In addition, the wooden surface provides better adhesion to conventional metal handrims.

Wood offers the advantage of very low weight despite its high strength. Furthermore, also those of you who want to protect the paint of your car will be better served by wooden handrims.

<u>FAQ</u>

What kind of wood is used to make Lignorims?

Our hand rims are constructed from Ash wood. Ash is a durable hardwood. It's also used for making baseball bats, so you know it can take a beating!

If I rub or scratch the pushrims too hard, will it burr or give me splinters?

The short answer is no. Unlike softer alloys like aluminum, there will be no edge or protruding burr from the Lignorim wood.

How are Lignorims constructed?

The Lignorims use a proprietary laminar structure, which give incredible strength to the hand rims. They will be equal to or stronger than titanium or aluminum hand rims.

How do the Lignorims attach to my wheels?

Lignorims use a standard tab mount. However we offer a third hole option for an additional mounting position, while other rims only have two.

How will the wood react to water and wet conditions?

These pushrims are perfect for wet environments. Due to the natural feel and texture of the Ash, the pushrims will not feel slick. Additionally, exposure to wet conditions over time will not warp or deform the rim.

How do Lignorims handle extreme temperatures?

Because of the natural elements found in Ash, the pushrims will not collect radiant heat or cold. The pushrims do not react heavily to extreme temperatures, therefore, when you touch your Lignorims they will always feel good. Never too hot and never freezing cold.

How do I clean my Lignorims?

Due to the finish of the pushrims being treated with natural oils, you can use warm soapy water to clean off any transfer or blemish.

DO NOT UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES USE ACETONE or ANY SOLVENTS on Lignorims as it will remove the finish and damage the integrity and color of the rim.

Will Lignorims burn my hands or fingers when going fast downhill?

Due to the natural wood having low thermal conductivity, Lignorims will get warmer than normal aluminum pushrims if moving quickly downhill, especially if you over-grip when braking. However in everyday settings, Lignorims perform better than their alloy counterparts.

Does Lignorim offer different shapes or colors?

Lignorims are available in 4 shapes; Light, Medium, Big and Prime. These 4 shapes are available in 3 standard colors and 6 custom colors.

Why would I ever use wooden pushrims?

There are several advantages and benefits of using wooden hand rims - here is a short list!

- Never too hot or too cold to the touch, no matter outside temp
- Unmatched performance in wet conditions
- Go Green by using a natural element from the earth
- Choose between 3 mounting positions on the tab
- 4 ergonomic shapes to choose from
- o Look better as they wear over time
